



Minutes of the June 9th, 2009 of the ADA Compliance Committee

Chairperson Diane Perry chaired the meeting. Minutes of the previous meeting were read and accepted. Treasurers' report showed \$328.50 in the treasury. A bill of \$19.95 for new "warning" parking tickets will be paid.

OLD BUSINESS:

1. Plain/Belmont Streets intersection- the proposal to place signage and crosswalks at this intersection has been presented to the town planning board; it is anticipated that selectmen will call a public hearing about this issue in the near future. There is a citizen's petition presented to the town about the lack of signage and crosswalks. This committee believes the proposal is especially important because school children are dropped off from buses at this intersection.
2. Pediatric Associates-issues remains unresolved.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Town Library-two member of the committee met with Beth Roll-Smith, library director, regarding installation of new carpeting for the library. The carpeting that is being purchases does meet all ADA requirements.
2. ADA Mission/School Handbook- a statement about the mission of the ADA compliance committee will be sent to the school superintendent's office at their request.
3. Football Field Renovation-it has been rumored that renovation to the football field is a possibility. After talking with Julie Hamblin, school custodian, it has been verified that no such renovation is in place other than the update of the irrigation system

With no further business to discuss the meeting was adjourned shortly after 8 PM. The next meeting will be on February 10, 2009 at 7 pm.
